Focus on South Africa **BLACK QUEER BORN FREES** featured in *Faces and Phases*

A three part lecture series exploring the visual culture of black LGBTI youth from various South African townships.

The visual activism approach will be used to understand realities of black queers born at the end of apartheid in SA focusing mainly on visual expression of the Black Queer Born Frees. The new generation born in the post-apartheid SA is also known as 'Mandela's step great-grandchildren.'
